This year the Committee will offer Piano, Vocal, Speech Arts as well as Band & Strings classes.

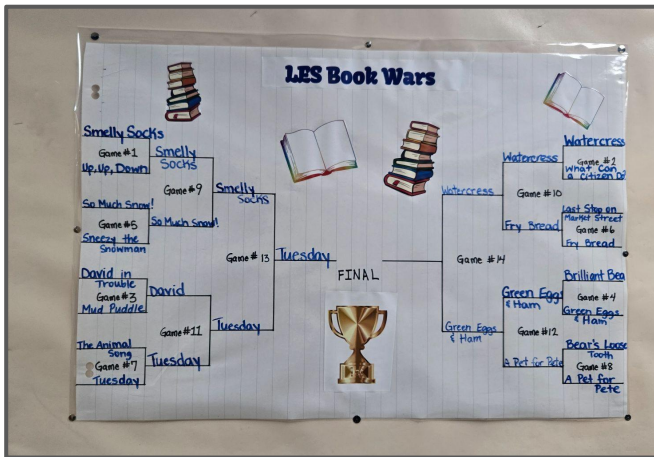

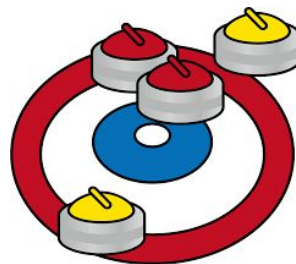
