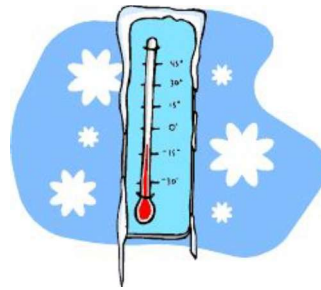

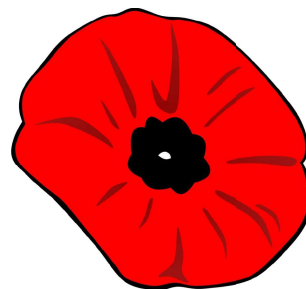
Parent Teacher Interviews
