Congratulations to our newly elected Student Council for the 2023 - 2024 School Year. We can't wait to see what fun activities they plan this school year.

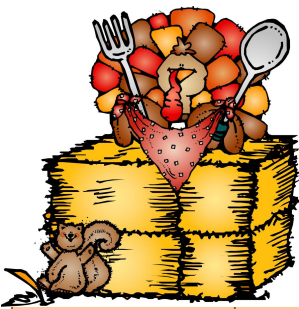
